- D. The board moved to amend the homeowner bylaws to include a weight restriction for animals. Currently, homeowners are only allowed two pets. The amendment would limit the total weight to a combined 40 pounds. Homeowners (in attendance and by proxy) voted 9-0 for the change. Not enough homeowners were present. Steven will send a notice to all homeowners and ask them to vote by ballot.
- E. The board moved to amend the homeowner bylaws to include a \$200 move-in fee for all new owners/renters. The fee would be assessed to a homeowner anytime someone moved into the apartment. The money would be placed in the maintenance budget and be used for repairs associated with people moving in and out of the building. Homeowners (in attendance and by proxy) voted 9-0 for the change. Not enough homeowners were present. Steven will send a notice to all homeowners and ask them to vote by ballot.
- F. Homeowner Issues:
 - Vincent stated the lights on the third-floor landing. First Avenue side, were out.
 - Joan stated water backs up into her apartment when someone does laundry in her stack.
- G. Roz Burgio announced she is stepping down from the board. Any homeowner interested in serving on the board should contact Steven Baratte in unit 22.
